The facilities include changing areas, an Olympic sized pool, a wading pool, and a separate diving pool with two 1-meter springboards and a 3-meter board. There will be a cash concession stand serving hot and cold food all day, and possibly vendors selling T-shirts and swim & dive accessories.

Eligibility

A diver's age on June 1 will determine that diver's age for the entire PASDA season including the championship meet. Divers are eligible to compete in the Championship Meet if they are on the submitted team roster and have competed in at least one diving dual meet during the season. Divers who are 18 may compete in 18 & under so long as they just graduated or are still in high school.

Events

Divers may participate in one or two events, including any combination of their age-specific group and the OPEN events. Divers may only "dive-up" in age for OPEN events, and there are no "B" events at the Championship meet. Any of the available 1-meter boards may be used by a diver during an event unless otherwise specified by meet officials. Events may run concurrently, but will be scored separately. Divers may practice their dives at the assigned warm-up times before their event starts. When scheduling allows, extended warm-up time will be given before each event.

Dive Requirements

6 & Under*	101 or front line-up, plus 2 jumps	6 or younger
8 & Under*	3 dives (max DD 1.7), 101 required At least one dive must be a jump	7 or 8
10 & Under*	3 dives covering 2 groups, 101 required One of the dives may be a jump	9 or 10
12 & Under	3 dives covering 2 groups, 101 required No jumps allowed	11 or 12
12/u OPEN**	5 dives: 2 voluntaries covering 2 groups 3 optionals covering 3 groups	12 or younger
14 & Under	4 dives covering 3 groups, 101 required	13 or 14
18 & Under	5 dives covering 3 groups, 101 required	15 to 18
18/u OPEN**	8 dives: 4 voluntaries covering 4 groups 4 optionals covering 4 groups	18 or younger

* Degree of Difficulty (DD) is correct DD (up to a max of 1.7) for all 8 & under dives. Jumps (100, 200, 5x0x) and line-ups (001, 002) have a DD of 1.0. Both 6/u and 8/u divers may balk twice without penalty. No jumps allowed at 12/u, 14/u, and 18/u.

****For the OPEN events (12/u and 18/u):** Voluntary dives must have a lower dive number than optional dives in the same category. Two failed dives will put a competitor out of the competition. Failure to attempt a dive listed may result in disqualification of the diver at the discretion of the meet referee. *Coaches should NOT be encouraging divers to participate in either of the OPEN events unless the divers are fully prepared to execute the required dive list in its entirety.*

Fees, Entries, & Dive Lists

Fees are \$10 per event for each diver. Payments should be collected by the club's Team Rep, and a single check made out to PASDA is due before the meet begins. Dive lists for each entry should be delivered electronically to the PASDA Dive Trustee by the team coach a week before the meet (see link at www.pasda.org under diving). Entries must be finalized at least 2 days before the start of the meet. Dives may be altered up to 15 minutes before the diver's event is scheduled and on the board at the discretion of the meet referee. Coaches are responsible for verifying accuracy of entries. Please be sure each participant's dive list is correctly numbered and ordered.

Judging & Announcing

We require coaches (or the equivalent) to serve as judges and announcers. We will continue to include a sixth judge, so that in no case will a coach be scoring their own diver. The intent is to have consistency, impartiality, and high quality. Non-coaches will be considered for announcing and judging as needed, but are definitely needed for marshalling and awards. A PASDA official should serve as the meet referee.

Awards, Scoring, & Results

The individual winner of each event will be awarded a trophy. Places 2 through 8 will receive medals, others will receive ribbons. Team trophies will be awarded to division winners of Dual Meet season and teams finishing first through third at Championships. Individual awards will be given after each event; team awards at the end of each day. Team scores will be tallied based on a divers finishing place in each event. Each event scores points for the top 16 finishers as follows: 20-17-16-15-14-13-12-11-9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1. Final results will be posted on the Internet (see link on www.pasda.org).

Hosting Responsibilities

Up to 3 coordinators may be assigned the following duties and will follow-up to ensure PASDA revenue is collected, and services are rendered as expected by PASDA.

- Photography Coordinator: recruit professional sports photographer who will take photos by request and donate a percentage of revenue.
- Vendor Coordinator: recruit vendor(s) who will sell aquatic accessories and T-shirts and donate a percentage of revenue.
- Hospitality Coordinator: ensure adequate supplies of water/ice are available to all judges, scorers, and volunteers during the day, as well as healthy snack in the morning. Arrange lunch for judges, scorers, and volunteers (use on-site snack bar by pre-arrangement or order simple box lunch). PASDA will reimburse expenses.
